"Spend a day on the byways in northern New Hampshire."

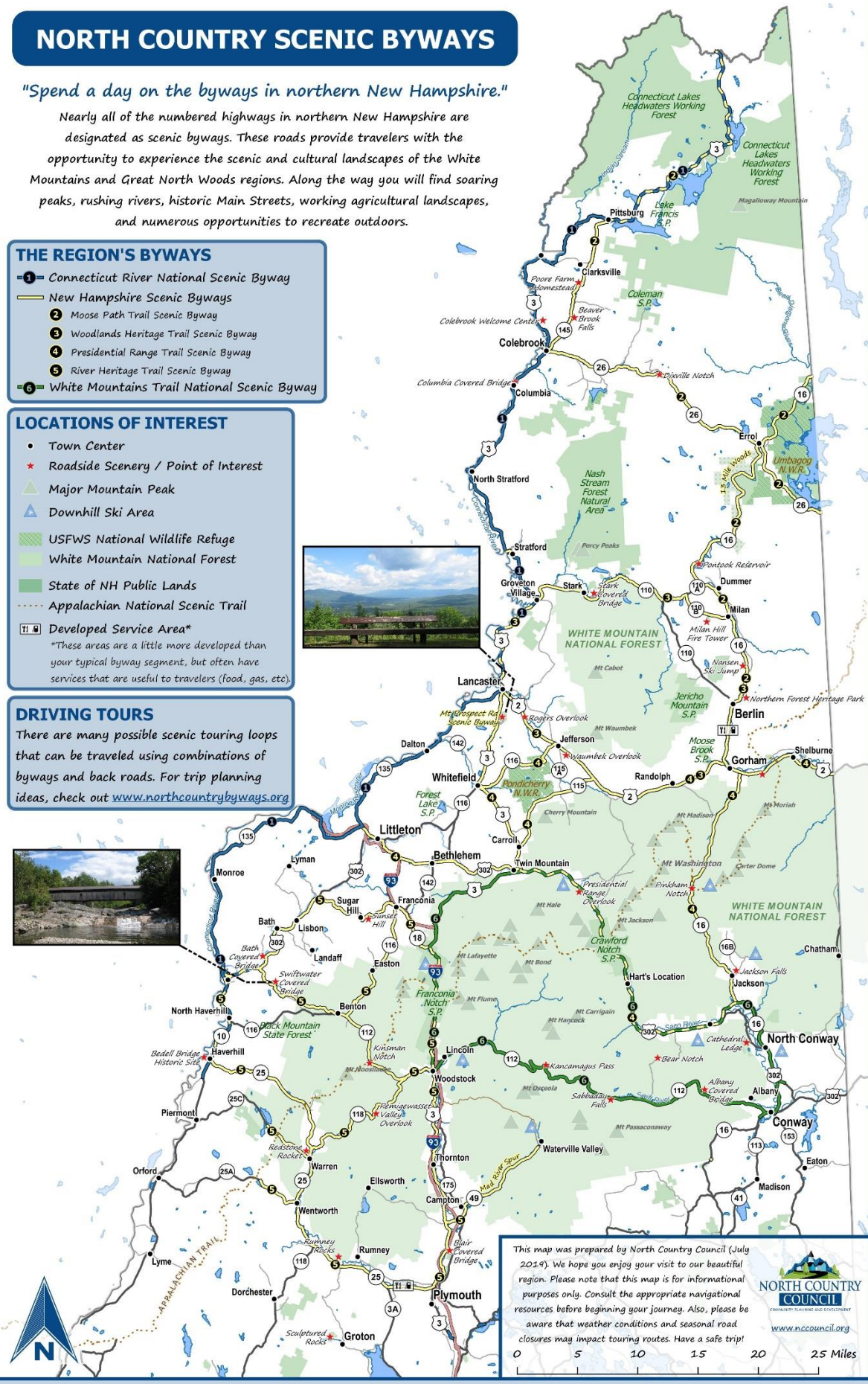
Nearly all of the numbered highways in northern New Hampshire are designated as scenic byways. These roads provide travelers with the opportunity to experience the scenic and cultural landscapes of the White Mountains and Great North Woods regions. Along the way you will find soaring peaks, rushing rivers, historic Main Streets, working agricultural landscapes, and numerous opportunities to recreate outdoors.
